

# **MANDATORY FACE COVERING / NON-MEDICAL MASK POLICY**

Related to Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic

## **Sherkston Supermart, Sherkston Café & Sherkston Laundry**

On July 23, 2020, as part of their efforts to slow the spread of COVID-19. Niagara Regional Council approved a by-law making it mandatory to wear a face covering or non-medical mask in enclosed public places.

The by-law comes into effect at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, July 31, 2020 and will remain in effect until Oct. 1, 2020 unless extended by Regional Council.

**A face covering or non-medical mask will be required for entry to Sherkston Supermart, Sherkston Café and Sherkston Laundry.**

**Any customer over 5 years of age will be denied entry unless they wear a face covering or non-medical mask upon entry and at all times while inside the premises.**

Those who claim a medical reason for not wearing a face covering or non-medical mask at the entrance door to Sherkston Supermart will be granted access on a "one claimant out one claimant in" basis. Only one unprotected individual will be allowed inside the premises at a time.

**We expect the wearing of masks by all individuals inside the business premises will facilitate easier access and less wait times for customers.**

**There will be zero tolerance for non-compliance or anti-social behaviour.**

There will be no discussion, argument or negotiation. Any attempt to enter without a face covering or non-medical mask, or, not following prescribed protocols or staff direction will result in customers being denied future entry.
